Subject: Significant Issues Update

1) County Administrator's Update on Contracts

The County Administrator signed the following contracts of significance since the last Significant Issues update:

- Department of Resource Management, a contract amendment with Richard Denton & Associates to provide technical and administrative support in the County's review and comment on the Bay Delta Conservation Plan (BDCP) EIR/EIS and other related documents, \$10,000 (bringing the total contract to \$35,000) for May 15 1, 2013 to June 30, 2015.

2) Solano County's Road Maintenance Project Update – Fall, 2014

The Public Works Operations Division of Resource Management will be involved in the road maintenance projects listed below. Throughout these projects, all efforts will be made to minimize traffic delays.

- Our Fall Chip Seal Program is planning to start Sept. 15th and conclude by Oct. 1st. Chip sealing is a road surface treatment of applied asphalt oil with small gradation of rock (5/16" in size) imbedded in curing oil. This process seals the road surface from water penetrating the road base which can contribute to road failures. We will be chip sealing various sections of roads covering approximately 33 miles in the vicinity of Dixon / areas around Vacaville/ and south of Fairfield in Solano County. Some of the roads planned for chip seal are two sections of Midway road, parts of Pleasants Valley and Cantelow roads and Ramsey road.

3) Solano County Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) Assists Napa County DCSS after Earthquake Damage

Due to earthquake damage, the Napa County Department of Child Support Services located at 929 Parkway Mall in Napa has been temporarily closed. In an effort to ensure a continuation of child support services, approximately 16 Napa DCSS staff has relocated to Solano County DCSS. The Solano County Department of Information Technology responded quickly to establish a network, set up phone lines and install equipment provided by State DCSS in the conference room at 435 Executive Court North in Fairfield.

Napa County staff reported to work in Solano County on Thursday, August 28th and is expected to remain until an alternative worksite is secured (in Napa).
