Re: People v. David Fanning

Today, in Department 23 of the Solano County Superior Court, before the Honorable John B. Ellis, the jury found the defendant, David Fanning, Guilty of Assault with a Firearm in violation of Penal Code Section 245(a)(2) and found to be True the enhancements for Personal Use of a Firearm and Personal Infliction of Great Bodily Injury.

On June 8, 2015, the victim went to the defendant's apartment and they became involved in an argument. The defendant was upset, because the previous night, the victim had been pounding on the defendant's door at 2:30 a.m. and shouting for 10 minutes before leaving.



During the argument on June 8, the defendant became more upset because the victim was laughing about the defendant being mad. The defendant paused during their argument to go into another room of the apartment and retrieve a gun. The defendant returned and shot the victim, who then hopped on one leg out of the apartment to safety.

Officer Chris Lechuga of the Vacaville Police Department investigated the case. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Brian Roberts.
